The union, originally known by the unwieldy name of the Intl. Assn. of Oil Field, Gas Well & Refinery Workers of America, became the Oil Workers Intl. Union in 1937. The OCAW's roots have been in small towns and rural areas outside the major urban areas of the Northeast and Midwest. This does much to account for the strong streak of independence and the persistent commitment to union democracy exhibited by the members of the organization over the years.
